The idea behind the project

- The ELEVATION Project is an innovative project that aims to develop a comprehensive and bespoke new learning framework to attract those furthest from the mainstream back into education and training;
- The new approach that pursues a more open and expansive provision based on embedded learning techniques and ,open-house' community learning festivals.

Project objectives

- provide access to lifelong learning for the most vulnerable groups of adult learners, in particular those lacking basic skills or having low level or no qualifications;
- make education work for the most marginalized groups to support their inclusion in society and economy.

Target groups

- The project primary target groups are:
- Adult education tutors who will benefit from the in-service training;
- Low skilled adults, migrants, refugees, ethnic minorities, etc.
