





Summary of the project

The ELEVATION project proposes to develop a comprehensive and bespoke new learning framework to attract those furthest from the mainstream back into education and training. This project will take a new approach that pursues a more open and expansive provision, one based on embedded learning techniques and 'open-house' community learning festivals. With new methods come new educational materials which will cover popular topics such as artistic disciplines, cultural disciplines, digital and social media, sport and hobbies. The idea of the project is to adapt these thematic frameworks to relevant educational disciplines in a simple and accessible way so that marginalised target groups can become interested in solving these kinds of challenges. The target groups are adult education tutors who will benefit from the in-service training and low-skilled adults, migrants, refugees and ethnic minorities, etc.
